


MAKE A BUDDY FOR BUDDY!

MAKE A DRAWING



HERE'S A STEP-BY-STEP WAY TO DRAW A LION!

MAKE A MASK



1. CUT A SQUARE FROM AN OLD CARDBOARD BOX THAT COVERS YOUR FACE. (DECIDE WHETHER YOU ALSO WANT TO CUT A HOLE IN THE SQUARE FOR THE LION'S MOUTH - LIKE IN THE FIRST PHOTO...)
2. CUT LOTS OF STRIPS OF PAPER FROM OLD MAGAZINES, WRAPPERS OR ANYTHING THAT YOU'VE GOT - IT REALLY DOESN'T MATTER - THE STRIPS CAN BE ANY COLOUR.
3. STICK THE STRIPS OF PAPER ALL AROUND THE CARDBOARD SQUARE USING GLUE OR STICKY TAPE. IF YOU DO USE GLUE, IT'S BEST TO ALSO GO OVER THE TOP OF ALL THE STRIPS WITH STICKY TAPE - FOR EXTRA STICK!
4. TURN YOUR MASK OVER - YOU HAVE A LION WITH AN AMAZING MANE - BUT NO FACE! SO, IT'S TIME TO EITHER DRAW OR CUT AND STICK SHAPES TO THIS SIDE TO MAKE THE FACE FOR YOUR BUDDY MASK.
5. FINALLY GET SOMEONE TO TAKE A PHOTO OF YOU WEARING YOUR MASK AND, IF YOU CAN, UPLOAD THIS TO SOCIAL MEDIA USING THE HASHTAG
