



EVE Spa Pop Ups

- On arrival at the Lagoon and On-X you will enter via the main doors, the pop ups are situated in the open areas at both sites. Face coverings must be worn unless exempt for medical reasons. Please sanitise your hands, sanitising stations are available.
- All appointments will be booked via EVE Spas phone lines on 0300 300 0266 or via our email info@eve-spa.co.uk please note bookings cannot be made at the EVE Spa reception as the spa will be closed.
- Please arrive at the pop up location alone
- Only arrive 5 minutes before your treatment time, a consultation form will be filled in at every visit.
- If you arrive showing any signs of coughing sneezing or being generally unwell you will not be permitted to have your treatment you will be asked to reschedule
- If you have any coronavirus symptoms please do not attend cancel your treatment
- Face coverings can be removed but only for treatments that require this to happen which is facial waxing/threading on the lip or chin areas.
- Please bring your own water
- If you are late for your treatment unfortunately it will not be able to take place
- Card payments only, payment will be taken at time of booking
- Everyone must adhere to social distancing rules where possible
- Name and contact number will be given at time of booking for test and trace purposes
- Each treatment area will be cleaned in between clients thoroughly
- Staff will be wearing appropriate PPE and will be changed for every client
- Screens will be in place at our nail stations but face coverings must still be worn
- Please note gel/polish colours may vary at each pop up location. If you have a shade in mind please try and let us know before your appointment.
- A patch test must be carried out before tinting treatments. This must be done at least 24/48 hours before the treatment. Please book a time and date for patch test to take place. If patch test has not been done we can't perform the treatment.
